GOLDEN VALLEY INNOVATION CENTRE PLANS REVEALED

West Cheltenham Partnership and Hesters Way Forum (HWF) ran a consultation event for local residents and organisations to work out how new businesses in to West Cheltenham can support the existing community.



The event took place at **Hesters Way Community Resource Centre in May** and revealed what local people would like to see as the Golden Valley Development progresses. For details take a look here;

In the mean time the planning application has been lodged for the first phase of Golden Valley, the innovation centre which forms the core of Golden Valley's vision. This ambitious, internationally significant space where government, business, academia, start-ups and the wider community come together under one roof will open in 2027.

Local concerns have been raised regarding the heights of the building and the adjacent properties as they will be very close to existing properties on Fiddlers Green Lane. The HWF has fed back community views in relation to this and the effects of construction traffic once the work starts. Ideas have been shared that could make the buildings more acceptable including limiting the number of stories, adding additional planting and increasing distances from the road.

It remains to be seen whether these community views will be taken into consideration when the final plans are agreed. To see all the plans and related documents including all the HWFs comments you can visit the planning portal here. The code for the application is **23/01875/OUT**



Community transport isn't something you generally think about until you or a loved one need it. If you have always had the convenience of your own car or great public transport, then why would you. Community transport fills the gap for those that can't get in the car for a quick trip, walk to public transport or easily access any other form of transport.

In general we take it for granted that we can get where we need to go when we need to but sadly there are many amongst us who cannot get where they need to go easily. How would you attend vital health appointments, go shopping for food or visit loved ones? This is the reality for many in Gloucestershire that are helped by community transport every day.



Community Connexions can only continue to help by increasing our volunteer base. If you own your own car and have some free time why not join our volunteer workforce and help your local community?

Give as little or as much time as you can, Monday to Friday. One of our volunteers said

"I enjoy being able to give back to my community and help those who need it most travel to where they need to go. An added bonus, is the new people I have met whilst volunteering for Community Connexions."

Should you need to use the volunteer car service please call 0345 6805029 to register and book your first journey, your carer is welcome to travel with you free of charge.

We also offer fully accessible minibus and driver hire to enable community groups and charities to organise special trips. Does your community group or charity have a trip you would like to take but no transportation? Get in touch today to see how you can help. Just recently we have taken

groups to Saul Junction to go on the Willow Trust boat, to the seaside, to the Black Country Living Museum, Cotswold Wildlife Park and many more.

ENRICH PROJECT

Each Tuesday from 10:30-1:00pm, local people meet to learn new ways to manage our health and wellbeing whilst having fun. We meet at Goldfoot House, Griffiths Avenue GL51 7BG. The project was started because Clare Davies, Community Investment Officer for the Housing Team at Cheltenham Borough Council learnt that people who live in St Marks die ten



years younger than people who live in more wealthy areas of Cheltenham. Horrified by this fact, she formed a partnership with Monkscroft Action Group residents' group and Cheltenham based charities to develop a new type of health and wellbeing project where people learn to manage their own health

Each week we spend 20 minutes on seated, strength training which has been proven by scientific research to support people to live independently for longer. We welcome people of all ages and abilities. Our oldest participants are in their 80s, some on mobility scooters and in wheelchairs and others are physically fit in their 30s.

We then have facilitators from a variety of organisations such as The Isbourne holistic centre and Wiggly food charity where we learn how to look after our physical and mental health and how to cook and eat using fresh ingredients. We have covered a wide variety of topics including tips to improve sleep, Tai Chi, reflexology, writing for wellbeing with Cheltenham Festivals, nature walks, adapted cycling with Goals beyond grass, yoga, mindfulness and meditation, diabetes management, museum on wheels with The Wilson Art Gallery, money mindset and crafting. We even had free tickets to see Julian Clary at Cheltenham literature Festival generously gifted to us by Cheltenham Festivals.

Enrich members have told us that they have really benefited from this group in many ways;

Gaining confidence to take part in physical exercise

"since starting Enrich, I am now walking for about 45 minutes everyday. I also do strength training 3 times per week. When I exercise I feel energized and it improves my mood"

Sleeping better

"I learned about the stages of the sleep cycle. I don't look at my IPAD as much and I don't watch as much tele. My sleep has improved to the extent that I'm now off sleeping pills and anti depressant medication".

Cooking healthier food


I've really enjoyed the cooking and have learned a lot from Ryan. I now prepare lots of meals using fresh ingredients from scratch. Ryan is excellent and he's passionate about cooking. He demonstrates to the group and then helps us individually"

"Wow, Its Tuesday. Great day ahead. I wonder what's going on today. Looking forward to new projects. Everything is different. Really love it all. Fantastic"

"Look forward to coming each week. Feel supported, curious, energised by the variety of things we learn about and physical activity"
