# Golden Valley Update

We're excited to be moving into a new phase for Golden Valley and wanted to share a quick update with you.

This summer, our contractor partner Bowmer + Kirkland will begin preparing the site and starting construction on the first phase, which includes IDEA and ROUTER (see location plan below). Throughout the programme they will be providing regular updates on progress up to completion in Spring 2028.

IDEA will be our central innovation hub. It is designed to build on Gloucestershire's strengths in cyber security and bring together expertise from fast-

growing sectors such as cyber, AI and communications.

It will create opportunities for collaboration between government, SMEs, start-ups, major tech businesses, universities and investors. We believe it will become a real national asset, and we're excited to see it take shape.

The second building in this first phase will be ROUTER. It is designed to make it easier for people to move around Golden Valley and connect with local neighbourhoods. It will include cycle facilities, e-bike charging, 453 parking spaces, showers and lockers, real-time travel information.

When complete, Golden Valley is expected to provide more than 2,500 homes and up to 12,000 jobs, as well as green spaces and community infrastructure.

And while we start work on delivering Golden Valley we are proud to be working with the local community on a series of initiatives. At the recent Cheltenham Science Festival we met lots of inspiring young people who used AI to create their own fantastic ideas for Golden Valley. We were really pleased to be able to sponsor this great event which brought together so many people.

We're also supporting coding and robotics workshops in seven schools through our Jam Coding programme. Springbank Primary Academy, Hester's Way Primary and St Thomas More Catholic Primary will be the next schools to take part in these hands-on sessions, which cover game design, programming, stop-motion animation and robotics.

By investing in these early skills programmes, we're helping to grow local talent around Golden Valley and giving young people practical digital experience that could lead to future careers in cyber, tech and R&D.

On Wednesday 5th August 2026, we'll be back at the No Child Left Behind Party in the Park, which we are proud to be sponsoring for a second year.

# Springbank Community Group Youth Work

At Springbank Community Group CiC, our youth work sessions continue to provide safe, welcoming spaces for children and young people across West Cheltenham. Through sessions in Springbank, Brizen and Churchdown, young people are supported to build confidence, friendships and important life skills while having fun in a positive environment. Sessions regularly include sports, team games, arts and crafts, cooking, wellbeing activities, competitions and trips.

Over the last year, young people have taken part in tie-dye workshops, healthy cooking, football tournaments, glass painting, music sessions and visits from organisations including Gloucestershire Constabulary and UK Parliament outreach staff. These opportunities encourage creativity, teamwork and confidence while helping young people learn about staying safe, healthy relationships and the world around them.



Youth club is often much more than activities. For many young people it is somewhere they feel listened to, accepted and supported through challenges at school, home or within friendships. Young people told us: "It's where I can be myself." "I've made new friends." "It gives me something to look forward to every week."

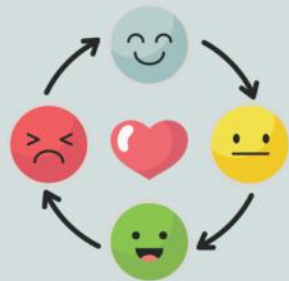

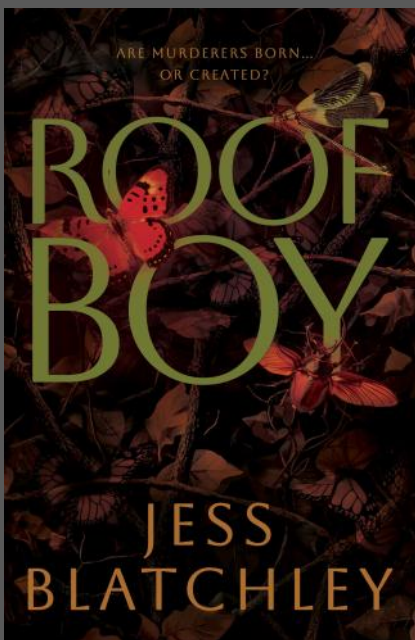

# Local author Jess Blatchley's chilling new thriller *Roofboy*

Jess Blatchley's chilling new psychological thriller *Roofboy* is set to captivate readers this summer with a dark, emotionally charged story that lingers long after the final page. Jess Blatchley continues to support survivors of spiritual abuse while balancing her work as an author, singer, and teacher. *Roofboy* marks a powerful and unforgettable addition to contemporary psychological fiction.

#### Helping around the home

With washing, getting dressed or getting to and from the toilet safely or Cooking, cleaning, shopping or laundry



#### Helping to get out and about

to appointments or to meet with friends and family, or to get to community groups



#### Helping people who care for others

Looking after another adult so the person who normally cares for them can get some time out or caring for children because their carers have physical or mental health barriers



#### Helping people with budgeting

paperwork or telephone calls

## PEER NAVIGATOR NATIONAL NETWORK

Access Social Care is a legal rights charity, supporting people and carers across the country to understand their rights in adult social care support and to achieve fair and equal access to support. Our Peer Navigators are based within your local community and can offer support online or, where possible, face to face at a community venue or carers group. The service is FREE and is designed to help you to understand what you and the person you care for are entitled to from adult social care services. We can support you to:

- Contact and communicate with adult social care
- Understand your rights and entitlements
- Create letters to send to the local authority
- Request a social care assessment for the person you care for
- Request a carers assessment for yourself and support you through the process
